Playing a crucial role in the heart of the defense, sweepers are often extremely intelligent ballers with great field vision and leadership skills. These players are also highly disciplined in that, no matter what is happening on the field, the sweeper must stay in position and protect the goal. Always scanning the field. Always thinking ahead. The sweeper's main job is to anticipate danger and minimize risk throughout the game.
